

## **SEMPA Postgraduate Education Committee**

The SEMPA Postgraduate Education Committee will make recommendations for establishing guidelines for PA Residency/Fellowship programs in emergency medicine. The committee will make recommendations for creating a repository of information for those who already have an EMPA residency/fellowship, those contemplating the initiation of a program, and for those interested in attending a program. The committee may designate subcommittees to address specific tasks.

### Objectives:

1. Research and evaluate postgraduate training curriculum and continue to improve and make recommendations for the following areas
  - a. Identify core competency requirements for satisfactory completion of an EMPA Residency/Fellowship
    - i. Evaluate current EMPA residency curricula as well as current physician EM residency curricula to provide framework for the development of recommended curriculum
  - b. Review essential amount of contact hours that curriculum should provide
  - c. Review amount of didactic instruction recommended for EMPA Residency/Fellowship
  - d. Review which critical administrative processes should be in place for EMPA Residency/Fellowship
  - e. Review, evaluate and create tools for the evaluation of learners in EMPA Residency/Fellowship programs to ensure consistency of education across programs
  - f. Discuss, evaluate, and make recommendations regarding ARC-PA accreditation standards
2. Maintain an EMPA Residency/Fellowship repository on SEMPA website
3. Evaluate current SEMPA EMPA Postgraduate Training & Practice Guidelines and make recommendations for additions/substitutions/deletions as necessary
4. Discuss and recommend a marketing strategy to PA students regarding EMPA Residency/Fellowship
5. Pursue strategic partnerships with other organizations that will contribute to the EMPA Residency/Fellowship goals and objectives
